CROSS-NATIONAL, QUANTITATIVE ANALYSES ARE COMPLEMENTED BY A QUALITATIVE CASE STUDY OF SOCIAL SCIENCE CURRICULA IN BRITISH COLUMBIA (BC), WHICH EXAMINES NATIONAL-BUILDING WITHIN A CONTEXT OF STRONG EMPHASIS ON DIVERSITY AND HUMAN RIGHTS. THE BC STUDY UTILIZES CURRENTLY APPROVED HIGH SCHOOL CITIZENSHIP EDUCATION TEXTBOOKS AS WELL AS OLDER TEXTBOOKS DATING BACK TO 1871. IT ALSO DRAWS ON A SELECTION OF HISTORICAL DOCUMENTS, INCLUDING MINISTRY OF EDUCATION REPORTS, CURRICULAR FRAMEWORKS, AND HIGH SCHOOL EXIT EXAMS. PROCESS-WISE, I FIND THE INCORPORATION OF HUMAN RIGHTS AND DIVERSITY REFLECTS MACRO-LEVEL CHANGES IN NATIONAL AND GLOBAL SOCIETY. CONTENT-WISE, I FIND FOUR MAIN APPROACHES TO RECONCILING IDEAS OF HUMAN RIGHTS AND DIVERSITY WITH NATIONAL IDENTITY: (1) FRAMING HUMAN RIGHTS AND MULTICULTURALISM AS PART OF NATIONAL IDENTITY, (2) USING PEDAGOGICAL APPROACHES THAT PROMOTE MULTIPLE PERSPECTIVES AND INDIVIDUAL AGENCY, (3) CELEBRATING SOCIAL AND SCIENTIFIC FIGURES AND ACCOMPLISHMENTS AS THE SOURCE OF NATIONAL PRIDE, AND (4) DRAWING ON EXOGENOUS SOURCES TO AFFIRM STATE LEGITIMACY. THIS STUDY IS ONE OF THE FIRST TO THEORIZE THAT CIVIC EDUCATION WORLDWIDE IS MOVING AWAY FROM A NATIONAL FOCUS AND TO PROVIDE EMPIRICAL EVIDENCE OF THIS TREND.
